Dear Colleague,

I want to congratulate you on your re-election, and I look forward to continuing serving alongside you in a unified Republican government. After four years as Chairman of the Western Caucus, I will not be running for re-election. It has been an honor to lead this organization, and I am incredibly proud of all we have accomplished together.
